



GROWING THE COMMUNITY OF CYCLING WITHOUT AGE

A new activity to keep Alaska seniors vibrant and healthy has arrived at the Providence Horizon House. Remember when learning to ride a bike as a kid was a big accomplishment and it was so much fun to cruise around the neighborhood with the wind blowing your hair? Those special moments in time are now being relived as residents climb aboard our new trishaw and once again feel the wind in their hair as they ride around Folker Park and nearby trails.

Cycling Without Age is a movement started in 2012 in Denmark by Ole Kassow. An avid cyclist, Ole frequently rode by a nursing center noticing the many residents sitting outside watching all of the activity going on. He wanted them to be able to participate so he had the perfect bike built — a two-seater trishaw. The first senior he gave a ride to was filled with so much joy and elation that the next day the senior center called Ole asking what he'd done!

When our team at Providence Horizon House heard about this wonderful activity, we worked with the newly created chapter of Cycling Without Age sponsored by Sons of Norway Bernt Balchen Lodge. Thanks to generous donors to Providence Alaska Foundation, we were then able to purchase our first trishaw which arrived in 2021.

Horizon House residents are excited about this new activity and are ready for more rides this summer. Wanda Sanborn says, "I just love it! I wish I could have gone for a longer ride."

Currently only a few staff members are trained as pilots to peddle seniors outdoors in the trishaw, but the opportunity is here to grow in numbers and share the outdoor beauty of Alaska with more of our seniors.
